

MEETING HELD ON 31ST MARCH 1909

The L.t. Governor was absent owing to indisposition.

POLICE BILL-- SECOND READING

The Crown Advocate moved the Second Reading of a Bill to make provisions for organisation, discipline, powers and duties of the Police.

The Land Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to.

The Crown Advocate moved that the Council go into Committee to consider this Bill.

The Land Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to.

SPECIAL COMMITTEE

After some debate the Land Commissioner proposed that this Bill be referred to a Special Committee consisting of the Treasurer, the Crown Advocate, Lord Delamere, Captain Cowie and the Land Commissioner.

The Treasurer seconded and this was agreed to.

COLLECTIVE PUNISHMENT BILL-- SECOND READING

The Crown Advocate moved the Second reading of this Bill.

The Land Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to.

The Crown Advocate moved that the Council go into Committee to consider this Bill.

The Land Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to.

COUNCIL INTO COMMITTEE

Section 5

The Crown Advocate moved to delete in Section 5 " as if it were an arrear of hut or ther tax " and substitute " by distress "

The Land Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to.

The Crown Advocate moved to report the Bill to the Council.

Capt. Cowie seconded and this was agreed to.

SUSPENSION OF STANDING ORDERS

The Crown Advocate moved the suspension of Standing Orders in order to pass this Bill through the Third Reading.

Capt. Cowie seconded and this was agreed to.

The Crown Advocate moved that the Bill be now read a Third Time.

The Land Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to.

The Bill was read a Third time.

POST OFFICE SAVINGS BILL

The East Arica Post Office Savings Bill was re-committed to the Council by His Excellency's instructions.

The Crown Advocate moved that the Council into Committee to consider this Bill.

The Treasurer seconded and this was agreed to.

COUNCIL INTO COMMITTEE

Section 20

The Crown Advocate moved to substitute "one <sup>Month</sup> ~~month~~" for "three months" in line 9, to insert "notice" after "such" in line 10 to delete "six" and substitute "three".

The Treasurer seconded and this was agreed to.

Section 17

The Crown Advocate moved to delete the words "of the provisions of this Ordinance..... made thereunder".

The Treasurer seconded and this was agreed to.

The Crown Advocate moved to report the Bill to the Council.

The Treasurer seconded and this was agreed to.

The Crown Advocate moved that this Bill be now passed as amended.

The Treasurer seconded and this was agreed to.

MASTER AND SERVANTS BILL

The Treasurer moved that a Special Committee be appointed to deal with the Master and Servants Bill, to consist of the Crown Advocate, the Secretary of Native Affairs, the Acting General Manager Uganda Railway, the Commissioner for Public Works, Lord Delamere, Capt. Cowie and Mr Wilson.

The Land Commissioner seconded

Lord Delamere proposed that a Special Committee consisting of the whole Council with the exception of the Lt. Governor be appointed.

The Treasurer withdrew his motion and seconded Lord Delamere's motion. This was agreed to.

MINING BILL

The Treasurer proposed that Lord Delamere be a member of the Special Committee in place of Major Leggett and Mr Sandiford in place of Mr Currie.

The Land Commissioner seconded and this was agreed to.

ADJOURNMENT

The Council adjourned sine die.
