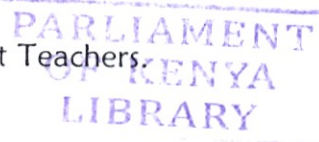

BY UNEMPLOYED EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT TEACHERS ON FAILURE BY THE GOVERNMENT TO EMPLOY THEM.

We, the undersigned unemployed Early Childhood Development Teachers,



DRAW the attention of the House to the following;

THAT according to the Constitution, 2010, Teachers Service Commission is mandated to register all teachers but they have failed to register the early childhood development teachers.

THAT according to Education Act 2012 the Government is mandated to provide free and compulsory basic learning (Early Childhood Development inclusive).

THAT the Ministry and Teachers Service Commission through the District Centre for Early Childhood Education (DICECE) program train Early Childhood Development teachers who are certified by Kenya National Examination Council for both Diploma and Certificate courses but are never employed by the government.

THAT the Ministry of Education through the Circular, Ref, PE: 18/37/Vol.11/(20) copied to all directors/ County Directors, Municipal Education Officers gave a disbursement of Early Childhood Development Capitation Grant for 2012/2013. In that capitation the Early Childhood Development Education caregiver was only given Ksh. 100 per child to cater for the year 2012/2013 which is a violation of human rights and despising the caregivers.

THAT according to child rights all children including those in Early Childhood Development Centers (under 5 years) have a right to free and compulsory basic education. This right has been violated hence leaving parents the burden to continue paying school fees.

THAT the Government employs all other categories of teachers save for ECDE teachers and aware that the Ministry of education directed all the Head teachers not to collect any fee from parents, thus it is unclear who should cater for all Early Childhood Development Education teachers' salary.

THAT, the average salary of an ECDE teacher is Ksh.5000 which is below the minimum wage set by the government.

That, we hereby confirm that efforts in terms of letters addressed to relevant ministries and oral representations to the concerned parties have been made to have the matter addressed no response have been given.

THAT, we confirm that the issues in respect of which the petition is made are not pending before any court of law or constitutional or legal body.

THEREFORE your humble petitioners **PRAYS** that Parliament;

- i) Revise the government Ministry's of Education budget and provide funds for the employment of ECDE teachers by Teachers Service Commission.
- ii) The Ministry of Education revise the content of the Circular Ref: PE: 18/37/Vol.11/(20) dated 13/1/2013 to expressly include a vote for payment to ECDE teachers sufficient enough to pay each teacher a minimum salary per month of Ksh 12000 plus other allowances such as housing and medical allowances payable direct to all ECDE teachers.

And your PETITIONER will ever pray.
