THAT Kenya's annual recurrent expenditure has passed the one trillion shilling mark and is unsustainable.

THAT given the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, has created a bicameral Parliament, County governments and Constitutional Commissions thus increasing recurrent expenditure.

THAT the bloated public sector wage bill, which has been growing over the years, enjoys the lion's share of the national budget, there there is need to carry out a job evaluation exercise in the public sector to gauge, regularize and rationalize pay levels, and to eliminate duplication and wastage.

THAT it is discriminatory to pay senior government executives salary rates of developed nations while the rest earn minimal wages by international standards.

THAT there is an urgent need to devise ways of bringing down the recurrent expenditure and increasing the development expenditure

THEREFORE your HUMBLE PETITIONERS PRAY that the National Assembly of the Republic of Kenya, audits the entire public service and state offices at both the county and national levels, including all commissions, to;

- i) Evaluate all public sector jobs and eliminate any duplications and unnecessary posts, especially ^{now that} as the National Government is trimmed down from 44 to 18 ministries.
- ii) Eliminate waste, mismanagement, and inefficiency in the government at both the national and county levels

We, the undersigned citizens of the Republic of Kenya, and who are also taxpayers

Draw the attention of the National Assembly to the following

1. THAT Kenya's annual recurrent expenditure has passed the one trillion shilling mark and is unsustainable.
2. THAT matters are going to get worse given the cost of implementing the new Constitution with its expanded bicameral Parliament, 47 county assemblies, 47 county public service boards, and 47 county executive committees, not to mention the many Constitutional Commissions
3. THAT there is an urgent need to devise ways of bringing down the recurrent expenditure and increasing the development expenditure



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4. THAT the bloated public sector wage bill, which has been growing in the years, enjoys the lion's share of the national budget.
5. THAT there is need to carry out a job evaluation exercise in the public sector to gauge, regularise and rationalise pay levels, and to eliminate duplication and wastage.
6. THAT it is discriminatory to pay senior government executives salary rates of developed nations while the rest earn regular Third-World salaries.

THEREFORE your **HUMBLE PETITIONERS PRAY** that the National Assembly of the Republic of Kenya, at this budget making process stage, audits the entire public service and state offices, at both the county and national levels, including all commissions, to:

1. Evaluate all public sector jobs and eliminate any duplications and unnecessary posts, especially as the National Government is trimmed down from 44 to 18 ministries;
2. Pursuant to prayer 1 above, amend the relevant sections of the Constitution, such as Articles 81(b), 175(c), 177(b) & (c), 197(1) to specifically limit the effect of Article 27(8) to appointed officials and eliminate exotic seats which represent no interests on the ground.
3. Regularise, rationalise and harmonise remuneration (salaries and benefits) across board from the highest to the lowest paid public servants with a view to reducing the wage bill as well as attracting and retaining skilled workers in the public service.
4. Eliminate waste, mismanagement, and inefficiency in the government at both the national and county levels.
