- 1) **THAT**, aware that there is a 40km- road that traversing Mbiri, Mugoiri and Murarandia Wards passing through the Ndikwe, Kahuro, Kahatia, Murarandia and Githambo shopping centers within Kiharu Constituency.
- 2) **THAT**, the said road was tarmacked upto 30km in spite of the Ministry of Roads promising to complete the remaining part (Murarandia-Githambo) in the 2013/2014 Financial Year;
- 3) **THAT**, the road was abandoned by the contractor after it was substantially completed up to 30km without explanation and that, the 10km road that is yet to be tarmacked from **Murarandia** to **Githambo** shopping centre, is impassable during rainy seasons hence crippling transport.
- 4) **THAT**, there is a Tea Factory (Githambo Tea factory Limited) along the 10km road that remains untarmacked and as a result economic activities like transportation of green leaves to the factory and processed tea from the factory remain hindered.
- 5) **THAT**, efforts to have this matter addressed by the relevant authorities have been unsuccessful.
- 6) **THAT**, we hereby confirm that the issues in respect of which the petitions is made are not pending before any court of law or constitutional or legal body.
