A REPORT OF THE DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE ON JUSTICE AND LEGAL AFFAIRS ON THE CONSTITUTION OF KENYA (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2015

1. PREFACE

Hon Speaker,

On behalf of the Departmental Committee on Justice and Legal Affairs, and pursuant to provisions of Standing Order 199(6), it is my pleasant privilege and honour to present to this House a report of the Committee on the Constitution of Kenya (Amendment) Bill, 2015.

The Committee derives its mandate from Standing Order No. 216(5) which provides as follows:-

- a) *To investigate, inquire into, and report on all matters relating to the mandate, management, activities, administration, operations and estimates of the assigned ministries and departments;*
- b) *To study the programme and policy objectives of ministries and departments and the effectiveness of their implementation;*
- c) ***To study and review all legislation referred to it;***
- d) *To study, assess and analyze the relative success of the ministries and departments measured by the results obtained as compared with their stated objectives;*
- e) *To investigate and enquire into all matters relating to the assigned ministries and departments as may be deemed necessary, and as may be referred to it by the House or a minister; and*
- f) *To make reports and recommendations to the House as often as possible, including recommendations of proposed legislation.*

The Second Schedule of the Standing Orders on Departmental Committees further states the subjects which the Committee is supposed to deal with while discharging its mandate. The subjects are as follows:-

- (a) Constitutional affairs;
- (b) The administration of law and Justice, including the Judiciary, public prosecutions, elections, ethics, integrity and anti-corruption; and
- (c) Human rights.

1.3. First Reading of the Constitution of Kenya (Amendment) Bill, 2015

The Constitution of Kenya (Amendment) Bill, 2015 was read for the first time on 11th February, 2015 and immediately committed to the Departmental Committee on Justice and Legal Affairs for scrutiny in line with Standing Order 127 (1) which states as follows:-

“A Bill having been read a First Time shall stand committed to the relevant Departmental Committee without question being put to it”

1.4. Public participation in the consideration of the Bill

Standing Order 127(3) states as follows:-

“The Departmental Committee to which a Bill is committed shall facilitate public participation and shall take into account the views

and recommendations of the public when the Committee makes its recommendations to the House”

Pursuant to this Standing Order, the Committee invited the public through the Daily Nation and Standard newspapers of 9th March, 2015 (See appendix 3) to make representations on the Bill. The Committee did not however receive any memoranda.

On 31st July, the Committee conducted public hearings on the Bill in Nairobi, Nyeri and Kisumu Counties while on 1st August, 2015, it conducted hearings in Mombasa, Isiolo and Trans Nzoia (Kitale) Counties where it received public views. It was not possible to conduct hearings in each and every County and the selected counties reasonably represented all regions of the country.

1.5 Sittings of the Committee and adoption of report

The Committee considered views received during public hearings on 4th August, 2015 in the Members’ Restaurant on 7th floor, Continental House, Parliament Buildings. The Committee considered and adopted its report on the same day and venue. The adoption of the report was proposed by Hon. John Njoroge and seconded by Hon. (Bishop) Mutua Mutemi. There was no dissenting voice to the adoption of the report. Minutes of the Committee’s sitting adopting the report are annexed hereto as appendix 1. A list of Members who attended the sitting is also annexed hereto as appendix 2.

1.6. Acknowledgement

The Chairperson wishes to commend Committee Members for their devotion and commitment to duty which made the consideration of this Bill a reality. The Committee further wishes to thank the Offices of the Speaker and Clerk of the National Assembly for providing guidance and technical support without which its work would not have been possible.



2.0. BACKGROUND

The Bill is dated 27th May, 2014 and is sponsored by Hon. David Ochieng, Member for Ugenya.

The principle objective of the Bill is to amend the Articles 101(1) 136 (2) (a), 177 (1) (a) and 180 (1) of the Constitution of Kenya by changing the existing dates for the general election for Members of Parliament and County Assemblies, the President and Governors and Deputy Governors from second Tuesday of August in every fifth year to third Monday in December of every fifth year.

The Bill seeks to introduce a new date for conducting a general election that would be more favorable to Kenya's circumstances. The amendment is to ensure that the date of elections reflects the unique circumstances and traditions of Kenya. The current date of elections unduly disrupts the education calendar, the tourism high season and the aspirations of a section of Kenyans who are able to get time out of their busy schedules to take part in general elections at their places of preference.

The Bill also seeks to clarify and put to rest all doubts that may exist in regard to the date of the next general elections and the term of the current parliament.

The Bill does not contain any provisions limiting any fundamental rights or freedom though it concerns county governments. Its enactment will however occasion additional expenditure of public funds.

3.0. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION IN THE CONSIDERATION OF THE BILL

Standing Order 127(3) provides as follows:-

“The Departmental Committee to which a Bill is committed shall facilitate public participation and shall take into account the views and recommendations of the public when the Committee makes its recommendations to the House”

Pursuant to this Standing Order, the Committee invited the public through the Daily Nation and Standard newspapers of 9th March, 2015 to make representations on the Bill. The newspaper advertisement is annexed hereto as appendix 3. The Committee did not however receive any memoranda.

On 31st July, the Committee conducted public hearings on the Bill in Nairobi, Nyeri and Kisumu Counties while on 1st August, 2015, it conducted hearings in Mombasa, Isiolo and Trans Nzoia (Kitale) counties where it received

public views. It was not possible to conduct hearings in each and every County and the selected counties reasonably represented all regions of the country. The list of members of the public who attended the public hearings are annexed hereto as appendix 4

(i) Outcome of the public hearings

In Kisumu County, members of the public declined to make representations on the Bill stating that they were prepared to do so only on the Two-Thirds Gender Rule Laws (Amendment) Bill. Every effort by the Committee to persuade them to make representations on the Bill fell on a deaf year.

In Nairobi, Nyeri, Mombasa, Isiolo and Kitale, an overwhelming majority of the public supported the enactment of the Bill on the following grounds:-

(a) Interference with the Budget making process

The Budget making process spans 6 months from April to September of every year. The Budget Policy Statement is submitted to Parliament in April followed by countrywide public hearings by the National Assembly on the Policy Statement in May. The National Treasury submits to the National Assembly the Appropriations Bill in June the same month of which the Minister for Finance reads the Budget Statement in the House. The Budget making process is finalized in September with the passage of the Finance Bill. The same process is also replicated in the County Assemblies.

The Constitution of Kenya provides for dissolution of Parliament 60 days before general elections. If elections are to be held on the 2nd Tuesday of August, it means interference with the whole budget cycle which also goes against the spirit of the East African Community treaty to which Kenya is a key member.

Both the National and County Governments have five year integrated development plans and holding elections in August, 2017 will disrupt such plans.

(b) Interference with the schools calendar

The Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) and the Kenya Certificate of Primary Education (KCPE) examinations are done in October and November of every year. If elections are held in August, and there is a presidential run-off whether court induced or where no Presidential candidate garners 50+1% of the total votes in the first round, then the run-off will interfere with the elections.

It should be noted that virtually all polling stations are located in schools and many teachers take part in the voting process as electoral officers and require time off to be trained for this job days before the voting.

(c) Interference with tourism activities

Kenya relies on tourism as one of its main income earners. August is the tourism peak season where many foreign tourists visit the country. A major tourist attraction activity which is the wildebeest migration from Serengeti National Park in Tanzania to Masai Mara National Park in Kenya and vice versa takes place from June to October of every year.

There is political tension associated with elections and should elections be held in August, tourists will shun Kenya thereby making the government lose out on much needed revenue for economic development.

(d) Disenfranchisement of voters

Many Kenyans in the major cities as well as the diaspora travel to their upcountry homes in December for Christmas and other festivities and prefer voting from there. Holding elections in August will deny them the opportunity of registering and voting in their most preferred constituencies thereby disenfranchising them.

(e) Interference with pastoral and cultural activities

Pastoralists are known to be moving from one area to the other with their livestock in search of pastures and water. August is usually the middle of the dry season country wide and all if not many of them are out there in search of pasture and water and cannot be able to vote where they are registered or any other place they would have preferred to vote since their exact movements cannot be determined in advance.

August is also a time when Communities in Western Kenya, Trans Nzoia and Uasin Gishu conduct initiation ceremonies to their young ones. The process commences in June/July with the climax in August.

(f) Unsuitable weather conditions for campaigns and voting in August

April to October are rainy seasons in a good number of areas most notably areas around Lake Victoria, Kericho, Trans Nzoia, Uasin Gishu and Western Kenya and holding elections in August will greatly interfere with the electoral process especially campaigns and actual voting.

There is no rain countrywide in November and December and this would be the most ideal months for campaigns and voting.

(g) Agricultural activities and electoral process

December is usually dry and thus very little agricultural activities are taking place country wide. At this time of the year, many farmers have already harvested their crops and are waiting for rains the following year to begin agricultural activities for the year. It is only at this time that they can be able to effectively take part in campaigns and voting. Further at this time of the year, farmers have already supplied their harvest and have been paid or are waiting to be paid the proceeds of which can be used to fund campaigns for those who are seeking elective posts.

4.0. CONSIDERATION OF THE BILL

The Committee considered the Bill on 4th August 2015 in the context of representations made by members of the public during public hearings and unanimously agreed with the public representations.

5.0. RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee recommends that the Houses passes the Bill in its published form.
