

RE: PETITION TO PARLIAMENT TO ENACT LEGISLATION REGARDING REGISTRATION OF POPERTIES.

I, the undersigned,

Gitonga Wathanga, a Kenyan Citizen, I/D # 5551093,

DRAW the attention of the House to the following:

That corruption has reached alarming levels and we need find new methods of fighting.

THAT

The House needs to enact new Legislation to make it more difficult and risky to engage in Corruption.

MY PRAYER:

That the House enacts Legislation to ensure the following:

1. That it becomes a mandatory legal requirement that to register any property in Kenya, one has to provide evidence of the transaction having being conducted through a recognized Bank.

The receiving and paying bank accounts should be those of the seller and buyer respectively.

The properties herein include and not limited to, Land, Buildings, Motor Vehicles, Motor bikes, Stocks, Aeroplanes, Boats, Ships, Helicopters and any incorporeal property.

- 2. The value of the transaction shall be declared.
- 3. That gifts be subject to the Anti-Corruption vetting verification
- 4. That inherited property be scrutinized and approved by the Anticorruption Agency

THAT

Petition to Parliament to Enact Legislation Regarding Registration of Properties.

- 5. That any person seeking Development Plans approvals provide proof of ownership of the land /property to be developed.
- 6. That Local Authorities provide the Anticorruption Agency (ies) with the Developer details of all approved plans within their jurisdiction.
- 7. A property developer shall be required to show his source of funds by the Anticorruption Agency during or after development of a property.

I have here before made the request to the Hon. Attorney General of the Republic of Kenya through a letter received in his office on 10th April. 2015. I however have had no response from him to date and hence my prayer to the Honorable House.

HEREFORE your humble petitioner pray that the National Assembly-

Enacts new or amends legislation to make it a mandatory legal requirement that all property transactions be conducted through a recognised Bank and that the names of the Account holders in the transaction be that of the Buyer and Seller.

AND your PETITIONER will ever pray.
